Anyway, I also learned that, if you remove from these definitions the idea of "God" as some supreme spiritual being who rules the world... what you're left with are words and ideas regarding what we humans believe are most important and most valuable to us, especially relating to what we deem is either right or wrong behavior... Words and ideas that elicit our most passionate feelings and inspire our most steadfast commitments to what we consider to be our highest principles... Words and ideas that express our deepest desires to live meaningful and purposeful lives... Words and ideas that call us to the uncommon lives we all crave!

Now, listen... I was raised a Christian, but ~ long story short ~ it ultimately turned out NOT to be a big enough tent for me... I simply don't believe that ANY one religion holds a monopoly on truth and righteousness... and no matter which religion you think is the one and only right one, I also reject the idea that all the "OTHER" religions are wrong or evil.

So, as far as I'm concerned, feel free to...
Throw out the idea of God as some Sugar Daddy in the Sky
Throw out the manmade myths and rituals
Throw out all the manmade rules and regulations of all the religions
If that's what works for you...

But please... "DON'T THROW OUT THE BABY WITH THE BATHWATER" just because I use the loaded language of "God Talk"! Remember, now... these RELIGIOUS words have matching SECULAR meanings. So, take what I say either way ~ or both ~ because I mean both, simultaneously.

Now, I realize that many of you have been horribly hurt by people, maybe even loved ones, who have weaponized their religion against you... and yes, we absolutely must acknowledge that there are far too many professed believers who tragically use their religion to choose winners and losers, and who personally judge who will "go to heaven" and who will "burn in hell"...
